Overview:

- The goal of the Chamber Ensemble Festival is to provide a positive musical and educational experience for solo and small ensembles, which should help foster musical growth both for the individual performers as well as support their school music programs.
- The Festival is open to Brass, Woodwind, Percussion, and any combination of those ensembles. We hope to expand to Strings, Guitar, and other ensembles in the future!
- There is no set music list! Any music is welcome, as long as a score can be provided.
- Due to time constraints, please plan to perform one piece only. Multi movement works are acceptable.
- Ensembles will be allotted 10 minutes, which should include entrance, set up, performance, judge feedback, judge scoring, and exit.

The Day of the Festival:

- Report to Check In with the following:
 - Entry Fee: \$5.00 for Solos, Duets, Trios, \$10.00 for Quartets, Quintets, or larger. Entry fees are for the total ensemble, not per individual performer (except soloists). Cash Only please.
 - Copy of music score: An original is preferred, but copies may be used if necessary
 - Percussion, please provide your own mallets and implements
 - All members of ensemble must be present to check in.
- The CVHS Band Room will function as the Warmup Room. Other rooms in the PAC will serve as the Adjudication Rooms: Woodwinds, Brass, Percussion.
- Mixed Ensembles will be assigned to rooms to help balance Judging Schedules.
- Ensembles can select to be adjudicated for Rating, or receive Comments Only.
- Upon completion, please return to Check In to receive both your score and adjudication sheet.
- Festival Ratings will be posted near the Check In area.
- The CVHS Band will have concessions for sale near the Check In area.
