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Chula Vista Field Tournament Director's Packet

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Directions: From the 805 Freeway:

Head South
Take Olympic Parkway and turn Left.
Buses and performer carpools will turn Right on Santa Venetia
Turn Right again on Santa Victoria
VIP Parking will be near the stadium.

From the 15 Freeway:

Head South, change to 805 South
Take Olympic Parkway and turn Left.
Buses and performer carpools will turn Right on Santa Venetia
Turn Right again on Santa Victoria
VIP Parking will be near the stadium.

From the 5 Freeway:

Head South until the CA-54
Head East on CA-54
Head South on CA-805
Take Olympic Parkway and turn Left.
Buses and performer carpools will turn Right on Santa Venetia
Turn Right again on Santa Victoria
VIP Parking will be near the stadium.

Parking: Buses will enter the Santa Victoria lot, and be directed to drive around the Gymnasium and park in the order of arrival. Bands that are carpooling will be directed to park in the Santa Victoria lot as well. 1A, 2A, 3A, 4A Equipment vehicles will be parked in the Santa Victoria lot. **5A and 6A Equipment vehicles will be parked in the Field Lot on Olympic Parkway. Please note your EQ vehicles will be separated from your buses.**

Spectator Parking: Spectator Parking will have two lots. The Santa Venetia lot at the front of the school, and the Grass lot on Olympic Parkway.



Check-in: Check-in will be located in the center of campus.

Wristbands: In your packet are wristbands for students **(Blue)**, parent helpers **(Green)**, 1 per 15 students max, and staff VIP wristbands **(Yellow)** based on the number of staff indicated on your application.

Admission: General Admission prices: Adults \$15, Military/Senior/Student (with ID): \$10, Children 5 and under: Free. The ticket booths will be open at 3:00 pm.

Warm-up: The campus area away from the stadium is open for warm-up are open for your ensembles to warm up. Percussion are allowed to go into the campus between buildings, but please stay away from the field area. Once the tournament begins, please face your horn line away from the stadium direction! Point of reference: If you can hear a performing group on the field, then the audience will be able to hear you.

Staging: Bands will enter the stadium and field from Side 2. Your student guide will lead your group there. Front Ensemble and props will also enter from the Side 2. Bands will be moved to a staging area and away from the exiting band. Band Exit will be Side 2. Booster parents will be on hand to assist with staging. Please see the map for more information.

Traveling to the stadium: Otay Ranch has some hills to the campus. Arrows below show the most direct pathway without using stairs.



Recording: At Check-in, each group will receive a video pass for the recording area. This pass is good for 1 person to record only.

Awards: The Awards Ceremony will begin after final tabulation of scores. Student leaders need to report to the Band Entrance area (Side 2 Visitor's side) as soon as the final band has finished competing. Trophies will be awarded by Class for Band, Guard, Overall Top 5 Percussion, and Sweepstakes Awards for Band, Guard, and Percussion.

Hospitality: The Hospitality Area will be located on the track of the field on Side 1. This area is for Directors, their significant others, Staff, and Judges.

Concessions: The Home Side Snack bar will be open for concessions.

First Aid: First Aid will be located at the Home side Concessions stand.

No BBQ's: In accordance with District Policy, no barbeques or open flames will be allowed on or near school campus.

Awards: Upon the conclusion of the final group, we will have student leaders meet at the Side 1 back area in performance order. Leadership will be called out and arched accordingly. The Awards Ceremony will begin towards the end of tabulation. Please instruct student leaders to present no more than a four count salute, to keep the Ceremony progressing. Upon the conclusion of the Ceremony, all leadership members should report back to their schools.

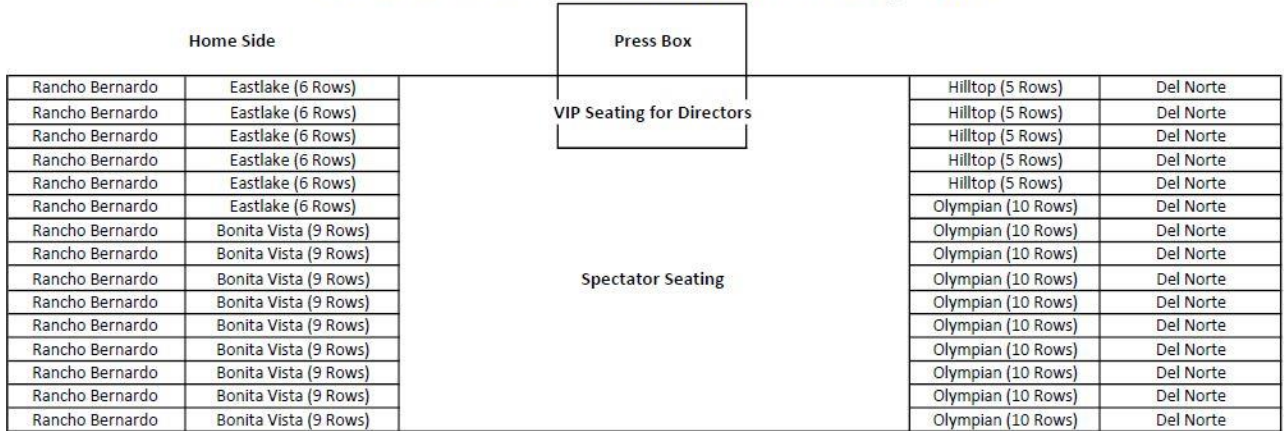
Seating: All will be seated in the Home side Stands. Please see the seating chart for your band's assigned area.

Please do NOT warm up in the parking lot after the tournament starts!

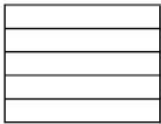
